## Volunteer Job Descriptions

**Parental Commitment:** The Buffalo Soccer Club is a volunteer organization. Any time/talent contribution you can give is greatly appreciated.

### **VOLUNTEER ACTIVITY DESCRIPTIONS**

**COACHES:** These coaches are asked to be at 99% of team practices. Men and women with soccer experience are greatly appreciated. However, our Director of Coaching and Player Development routinely holds free coaching clinics to train coaches. We have materials to help you teach skills and develop interesting practice plans. **DON'T BE AFRAID TO TRY.**

**ASSISTANT COACHES:** These coaches are asked to be at 50% of team practices. Coaches will be tasked with aiding the head coaches in running practices. Planned sessions will be provided to the assistant coaches and will be explained by the head coach. We would like to provide each team with at least one assistant coach each day. If enough parents volunteer, the time commitment will be less. No soccer experience is required - just a positive attitude.

**TEAM MANAGER:** Team managers are asked to help remind the kids to check in and help with administrative duties for the age group.

***The above volunteers are asked to arrive at least 15 minutes before practice is supposed to begin.***

**SNACK PARENT:** House League parents are asked to take a turn bringing a post-game snack and drink for the outdoor leagues. The Snack Parent would be in charge of coordinating these snacks.

**DAY OF VOLUNTEER:** These volunteers are asked to help keep the kids focused and on task. The volunteers will be required to show up on certain days (as requested by the head coach) and provide assistance.

**FIELD MARSHALL:** The field marshall will be charged with helping on game days. They will need to help set-up and tear-down the fields and will assist the coaches as needed.

Parent of players receiving **financial assistance will be expected to volunteer during the House League Season!** BSC was created to offer soccer opportunities to all of the children in the city of Buffalo. This included those without the means to pay for their own experience. If you have a child who wants to play, but you cannot currently afford to pay please let us know.

We ask that those receiving financial assistance step up and volunteer. Assistance includes some or all of the following: tuition waivers, soccer cleats, shin guards, and other equipment needs.
