Travel Soccer

Travel soccer is a competitive level soccer program for players who want to play soccer every week with the same coaches and teammates. All practices and home games take place at the JFK soccer fields on Clinton and Hickory. The team competes in the Buffalo & Western New York Junior Soccer League, which means our away games are at different fields around Western New York, such as Kenmore, Orchard Park, Akron, etc.

Who Can Play?

- Boys and girls with birthdays from August of 1999 to July of 2004 (U10-U12 teams)
- Girls with birthdays from to July of 1999 to August of 1997 (U14 girls team)

When Does the Team Play?

- January thru March –TBA indoor practices
- April thru July – full season of games and practices (practice 2 days a week, 1 game a week)
- We expect players to be able to make all games (1x a week) and practices (2x a week) during the April-July season

How Do I Try out for a Team?

- Tryouts will be held at the JFK Center for the 2012 teams on Thursday, September 15th, and Monday, September 19th
 - All tryouts will be from 6:00pm-7:00pm
 - Players should arrive 15-20 minutes early for check-in and warm-up

How Much Does It Cost?

- The program costs \$75 for the year (Financial Assistance Available)
- **A \$25 deposit is due by October 1st, please talk to Anna-Lesa**
- This includes registration fees, referee fees, uniforms (jersey, shorts, and socks), player insurance, indoor rentals, etc.
 - We will base the ability to have teams on this \$25 deposit

What Equipment Do I Need to Participate?

- Shin guards are required
- Soccer shoes are suggested

Volunteers Needed...

Teams will be required to have the following parent volunteers in order for a team to exist:

- **At Least 1- Head Coach** – Be responsible for being at 99% of team games and practices
- **At Least 1- Assistant Coach** – Be at a minimum of 75% of team events
- **At Least 1- Team Manager** – Help with administration of team soccer events
- Team Parents – Help with team parties, half-time snacks, etc.
- Carpool Volunteers – Be responsible for players who can not provide own transportation to away games
